EXAM: DXA AXIAL

INDICATION: Postmenopausal. Risk factors for osteoporosis include no additional risk factors reported.

COMPARISON: August 25, 2009.

FINDINGS:

Spine: Total BMD of the spine L1-4 is 0.824 g/cm², with a T-score of -2.0 and a Z-score of -1.1.

Left Femoral Neck: BMD is 0.665 g/cm², with a T-score of -1.7 and a Z-score of -0.8.

Left Total Hip: BMD is 0.825 g/cm², with a T-score of -1.0 and a Z-score of -0.4.

Right Femoral Neck: BMD is 0.660 g/cm², with a T-score of -1.7 and a Z-score of -0.8.

Right Total Hip: BMD is 0.812 g/cm², with a T-score of -1.1 and a Z-score of -0.5.

There has been a 14% decrease in BMD of the lumbar spine and a 9% decrease
