

## BONE DENSITOMETRY:

Clinical data: Osteoporosis screening. Status post partial hysterectomy. History of steroids. below 2,5 -1.8

Findings: The lumbar spine is osteopenic (T-score of -1.9).

There has been no significant interval change since the previous examination of 8/28/2015.

The left proximal femur (total) is osteopenic (T-score of -1.8).

There has been a statistically significant -6.7% interval decrease change since the previous examination of 8/28/2015.

The bone density in the right proximal femur (total) is normal (T-score of -1.0).

There has been a statistically significant -5.2% interval decrease change since the previous examination of 8/28/2015.

FRAX RESULTS: The probability of a major osteoporotic fracture is 28.8% within the next 10 years. The probability of a hip fracture is 6.9% within the next 10 years.
