Please notify patient that her DEXA shows severe osteopenia of the spine and moderate-severe osteopenia of the hip. She should still be seen in Rheumatology for history of osteoporosis. She needs to continue to get total of calcium 1200 mg and vit D 1000 IU daily and continue weight bearing and weight resistance exercises.
